## **BUSING GRANTS**

Busing grants may be available to assist groups attending arts events that might otherwise be inaccessible because of transportation issues. This program primarily serves groups living a distance from major Pennsylvania cities and for inner-city audiences from whom public transportation is inadequate. This program covers only busing and does not include the cost of admission to the arts events. *Trips to events outside of Pennsylvania will not be supported.* 

The group must make its own provisions for the purchase of tickets to the events. In most cases, the group attending the arts event and not the arts organization attended should apply. If the group attending is not incorporated, the organization producing the event may apply on their behalf, if a letter of intent from the attending group is enclosed. This is a non-matching grant.

Each year, funds are awarded on a first come, first served bases until all grants funds have been expended for the year. Citizens for the Arts in Pennsylvania manages busing grants through the Professional Development and Consulting grant program for the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts (PCA).
