The Huron County Corn Growers Association (HCGA) board of directors has established a student scholarship. Applicants must be a high school senior and presently enrolled in FFA. Applicants must be applying to be a full-time student at a post-secondary ag-related educational institution in order to be eligible. **All applications must be received by the Huron County Corn Growers Association 1398 Popple Rd. Bad Axe MI 48413 no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday March 14th 2018.**

A minimum of two scholarships in the amount of \$500 each will be awarded. Checks will be given at the HCGA annual meeting directly to the parents/student. Students are only eligible to win an HCGA scholarship one time.

The individuals selected for the 2018 scholarships are expected to attend the Huron County Annual Meeting 2018, time and place TBD. Recipients' of the scholarship will be notified one week prior to the annual meeting.

Students in an accredited agricultural program are eligible for a one-year membership in the MCGA for \$20. Grower and associate memberships in the MCGA are \$60 for one-year, \$155 for three-years, or \$500 for a lifetime. Membership in the MCGA automatically enrolls you for membership in the National Corn Growers Association. A MCGA membership is not mandatory for this scholarship.
