 - Not responsible for under 18
 - Accepting volunteers until May 31st
 - Adult fencing crews w/fencing/farm/ranch experience. Must be prepared to accept the rough terrain and working conditions
 - 24-48 hrs notice required by phone
 - Check in by 8am required for crew dispersal or call to prearrange appt.
 - Dinner and breakfast served. Pack your own lunch.
 - Camp sleeps 50-80 a night
 - Crews/groups please bring the following
 - Skid steer/ other machinery if possible
 - Leather fencing gloves
 - Useful fencing tools & equipment
 - Fence stretchers and fencing pliers
 - Windy and rainy Weather sturdy apparel
 - Lunchboxes and lunch food
- Kitchen open until April 30th ONLY
- Bunkhouses open till May 31st ONLY
 - After May 31st, the camp will not be open for the wildfire relief effort. Volunteers will be accepted but very limited and housed elsewhere privately on a prearranged basis. Contact Holly Fast at the number above for more info.
