

8. In a literal hell, it is the eternal punishment for the unsaved. (Lk. 16:19-31; Rev. 20:11-15)
9. In salvation by grace alone through faith alone in the final redemptive blood sacrifice of Jesus Christ on Calvary. (Eph. 2:8-9)
10. In the God-ordained institution of marriage between one man and one woman. (Gen. 2:18-25; Eph. 5:22-33)
